

DO YOU NEED TO REGISTER YOUR BOAT?

You must register your boat, personal watercraft/PWC (Jetski), or shuttlecraft, with a motor attached, if you own and operate it in the state of VT, on the waters of this state, unless you live out of state and your boat is already registered in your home state or your boat has a valid document issued by a federal agency (Vermont resident or non-resident).

Note: Any watercraft (shuttlecraft) which is propelled by other powered watercraft, docked or attached to it, must be registered as a motorboat in addition to the personal watercraft/PWC (Jetski) being registered.

OUT OF STATE REGISTRATION:

You may operate in Vermont for a period of 90 consecutive days if your home state grants like privileges to Vermont boats or your boat has a federally issued number. However, if you use your vessel in Vermont waters for 30 days or more you must obtain a vessel validation sticker. This validation of your out of state or federal registration will be in effect through December 31 each year. Use form TA-VD-113 (Application for Vessel Validation) instead of this form.

OPERATING A BOAT IN VERMONT:

All persons born after January 1, 1974, must have successfully completed an approved boating safety education course to legally operate any motorized vessel (this includes personal watercraft). Persons required to have completed the course must carry his or her course certificate on board when operating a motorized vessel. No one under 12 years of age may legally operate any vessel powered by a motor of more than 6 horsepower, even if the person has successfully completed a boating safety education course. No one under 16 years of age may legally operate a personal watercraft, even if the person has successfully completed a boating safety education course.

VERMONT TITLE REQUIREMENTS

As of July 1, 2007 Vermont titles vessels that are 15 years old or newer, based on calendar year, with a length of 16 ft. or longer (including shuttlecraft). Example: from 1/1/2011 – 12/31/2011 Vermont will title all vessels with model year 1997 or newer, with a length of 16 ft. or longer.

TITLE EXCEPTIONS: (a registration may be required even if exempt from title. For further information call 802.828.2000)

1. Any vessel which is a canoe, kayak, or similar watercraft designed to be manually propelled or such a vessel equipped with a motor of 10 horsepower or less.
2. Any vessel regularly engaged in the interstate transportation of persons or property for which a currently effective certificate of title has been issued in another state.
3. Any vessel owned by the United States Government, unless it is registered in this state.
4. Any vessel owned by a manufacturer or dealer and held for sale.
5. Any vessel owned by a non-resident of this state and not required by law to be registered in this state.

The following documentation is required for a first-time Vermont Motorboat Registration:

Vermont Use Tax form SU 452 must be completed if you are subject to tax, and this is a private sale, and submitted with this application and supporting documents as outlined below. If this is a sale through a dealer, the dealer must send sales tax to the VT Dept. of Taxes using the VT Use Tax Form SU-452.

The first registration personal watercraft in Vermont is subject to the sales tax unless:

- A purchase invoice is presented showing a sales tax of 6% or more paid to a dealer in any one of the 45 state jurisdictions imposing a sales tax.
- The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in a state other than Vermont while a nonresident.
- The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in Vermont, however, received title or possession or both in another state.
- The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and submits a copy of a valid registration from his home state.
- The vessel is acquired through a transfer to an individual (relative or not) for no consideration.

Titleable Vessel

Vessel is new (not previously registered anywhere):

- Original Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (If assignment made by other than Dealer, title of one signing must be indicated or Power of Attorney Appointment submitted.)
- Bill of Sale (for sales tax purposes)
- Additional Bill of Sale (all Bills of Sale must include the make, year, Hull Identification Number, purchase price, date and signature of Seller)

Vessel is used (has been titled previously):

- The original (previous) Certificate of Title Must be signed by all parties listed as owners on the face of the title. All liens must be released. Death Certificates &/or probate letters when owner(s) is/are deceased
- Bill of Sale (all Bills of Sale must include the make, year, Hull Identification Number, purchase price, date and signature of Seller)

Vessel is used (not previously titled):

- Original or certified copy of last Registration Certificate and all Bills of Sale thereafter
- Non-Titleable Vessel
- A Bill of Sale (from Seller to you describing the vessel by Hull Identification Number, make, year, date of sale, purchase price and Seller's signature, or
- Seller's signature (in Section 5B, or
- Copy of out-of-state Registration Certificate in your name

INSTRUCTIONS

WHO SHOULD USE THIS FORM?

- Buyers not required to file Vermont Sales & Use Tax returns (Form SU-451) should use this form to report the Vermont Use tax due on all purchases of tangible personal property for which a Vermont Sales Tax was due and not paid at purchase.
Buyers should also use this form to report all purchases of boats and snowmobiles to facilitate registration.

WHO SHOULD NOT USE THIS FORM?

- This form is not to be used by persons who should report both Sales and Use taxes on form SU-451.

WHEN IS A USE TAX DUE?

- A Use tax is due if no sales tax was paid on purchases of tangible personal property used or stored in Vermont. Examples: Items ordered from catalogs, out-of-state purchases, publication subscriptions, boats, snowmobiles, and aircraft.
Property purchased out-of-state, brought into Vermont, and used in a business is also subject to the Use tax.

WHEN IS A USE TAX NOT DUE?

- On local option tax.
A Use tax is not due on any property if a Sales tax of at least 6% was paid legally to another state.
Property purchased out-of-state and brought into Vermont by a nonresident for personal use is not subject to the Use tax. Persons owning real property in Vermont are not considered nonresidents.
Casual sales (items purchased from someone other than a business or dealer) are also exempt. Nonmotorized boats less than 16 feet in length are an exempt casual sale. All other sales of boats, snowmobiles, and aircraft are subject to the Use tax.

REGISTRATION OF BOATS AND SNOWMOBILES

If you did not pay a Sales tax to a dealer when you bought your boat or snowmobile, mail this return, together with your check or money order for the registration fee, any potential title fee, and Use tax, to the Vermont Department of Motor Vehicles, 120 State Street, Montpelier, VT 05603.

You must submit proof of payment (such as a purchase invoice, or an exemption from tax) before a registration certificate can be granted. Keep a photocopy of this tax return for your records.

ALL OTHER PURCHASES

If the purchases reported do not involve boats or snowmobiles, mail this return, together with your check or money order to the Vermont Department of Taxes, PO Box 547, Montpelier VT 05601-0547. If you are reporting the tax on more than one item, attach a list of the items, identifying each as requested on the front of this form.

CREDITS

You may be able to take one of four possible credits against the purchase price in order to arrive at the amount subject to Use tax:

A Any like kind trade-in credit allowed by the seller. This credit applies to all property.

B The amount received from the sale of a boat or snowmobile which was registered in your name. This credit applies to boats and snowmobiles only, and cannot exceed the book value. The sale must occur within three months before or after the purchase being reported on this return.

If the sale has already occurred, enter the amount received, or the book value, on Line 2. If the sale occurs after the purchase reported on this return, you may apply to the Department of Taxes for a refund of tax already paid on this purchase.

In either case, a photocopy of the sales invoice must be included when you file this return.

C and D Insurance money received for a boat or snowmobile totally destroyed or damaged within three months prior to the purchase being reported on this return. You may not claim an insurance credit if the boat or snowmobile has been repaired and you are claiming a credit for sale or trade-in of the repaired item. The insurance credit applies only to boats and snowmobiles.

FILING DEADLINE

This tax return is due on or before the 20th day of the month following the purchase, or at the time of registering a boat, snowmobile, or aircraft, whichever is earlier.

LATE FILING AND LATE PAYMENT CHARGES

Any tax due and unpaid by the due date of this return will bear interest at the statutory rate, and a penalty of 5% per month, up to a maximum of 25%, may be assessed. Late filing may also result in the imposition of a \$50.00 late filing fee. Please call Taxpayer Services Division of the Department of Taxes at (802) 828-2551 with any questions you may have.

5B The name and address of the seller and date purchased is information required for new and transfer Vermont registration, even if the vessel has been registered and titled to you out-of-state. The signature of seller is required only for dealer transactions and non-titled vessels when there is no Bill of Sale.

6A To be completed by dealers only.

The first registration or validation of a vessel/personal watercraft (Jetski)/shuttlecraft in Vermont will be subject to the sales tax unless:

1. A purchase invoice is presented showing a sales tax of 6% or more paid to a dealer in any one of the 45 state jurisdictions imposing sales tax. Alaska, Montana, Delaware, New Hampshire, and Oregon do not have Sales and Use tax.
 2. The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in a state other than Vermont.
 3. The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and purchased the vessel in Vermont; however, received title or possession or both in another state.
 4. The applicant is a nonresident of Vermont and submits a copy of a valid registration from his home state.
 5. The vessel is acquired through a transfer to an individual, relative or not, for no consideration.

Any claim of exemption from sales tax other than outlined above must be approved by the Tax Department; call (802) 828-2551 TAXABLE MOTORBOAT TRANSACTIONS OR "GIFT" TRANSFERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY TAX FORM SU-452 UNLESS THIS IS A VERMONT DEALER TRANSACTION AND SECTION 6A IS COMPLETED.

A visual verification of the hull identification number (serial number) of your vessel is required if the vessel is required to be titled and:

- Was last registered/titled in another state (unless purchased from out of state dealer for the purpose of registering in VT), or
 - Has a Salvage Title, or
 - Is registered under bond, or
 - Is imported from Canada without a Certificate of Origin or a new vessel information statement, or
 - The title documentation is from another country, or
 - Has a U.S. Government Certificate of Release of Motor Vehicle document.

The Motor Vehicle Department will assign the motorboat registration number. The owner shall either paint the number on each side of the bow (front section) of the motorboat or purchase the numbers and attach them to each side of the bow. The registration numbers must be positioned and of a size so that they are clearly visible.
