SPECIAL SAFETY / SERVICE ORGANIZATION PLATE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Safety and Service Organization plates are issued under the following conditions:

- ▶▶ Safety and Service Organization plates may be issued for a pleasure car (automobile) registered at the current pleasure rate or a truck registered for 26,000 lbs. or less.
- ▶▶ A separate application must be made for plates for each vehicle.
- ▶▶ Delivery may take up to 30 days from date of application. A temporary plate may be issued to the applicant if required.

1. Complete the first 2 sections of this application. If the application is not properly completed, it will be returned to you. Application must be signed by the registered owner.
2. The applicable part of the 2nd section should be completed by the eligible applicant.
3. Signature must be in ink. All other information must be printed in ink or typed.
4. Only eligible members of safety or service organizations that have been authorized by their organization may apply for a Safety/Service Organization plate.
5. The vehicle listed in Section 2 must be registered in the name of the authorized applicant (owner, co-owner and lessee) or a special organization plate will not be issued.
6. Applicants for Vermont Amateur Radio Operator plates must enter their FCC Call sign. Both “O” (ocean) and “0” (zero) will be allowed on amateur operator plates only. The “O” (zero) must be clearly identified by a slash (/) mark.
7. Amateur radio operator plates are limited to a maximum of six characters including one numeric character. Fewer characters than six will be automatically centered on the plate.
8. If the vehicle indicated in Section 2 is currently registered in Vermont, only the Special Plate fee of \$15.00 is due. If the vehicle is not currently registered in Vermont, complete a Registration, Tax and Title Application. Submit all fees for registration, in addition to the \$15.00 Special Plate fee and this application. Payment must be made in U.S. Funds.
