## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Vermont Veterans Recognition plates are special motor vehicle license plates for Veterans,. These license plates may be issued for use only on vehicles registered at the pleasure car rate or on trucks registered for less than 26,001 lbs. at the applicable fee. **The plates shall be reissued only to the original holder of the plates or the surviving spouse.**

These license plates will be issued bearing a distinctive number series, therefore, requests for "personalized" or vanity number plates will not be accepted.

Original forms are not required. Faxed copies will be accepted as long as they contain the required certified stamp and authorized signature.

Submit your application to the Vermont Office of Veterans Affairs for certification after sections 1 & 2 are complete. The Office of Veterans Affairs will forward the completed application with Veteran certification to the Department of Motor Vehicles for processing.

**Please submit this completed application along with your renewal notice and required fees (if applicable).**

### **SECTION 1**

Please provide all requested personal identification information. If the address indicated is different than our records we will consider this a notification of change of mailing address for all your records.

Please provide all requested vehicle information. The renewal notice for the vehicle, Form TA-VD-100 or your Registration Certificate will have the preprinted information required to complete Section 1. Please be sure to read your renewal notice and provide the information and fees requested if also renewing your registration.

### **SECTION 2**

Select the plate type that you are requesting and then sign and date the application. A plate type must be selected or the Office of Veterans Affairs will send the application back to you for completion.

**Your signature is required for your application to be processed.**

### **SECTION 3**

When sections 1 & 2 have been completed attach a copy of the DD Form 214 to this form and mail both forms to:

Applications submitted without certification by Vermont Office of Veterans Affairs or the signature of the applicant will be returned to the applicant.

**The Office of Veterans Affairs will forward the completed application with Veteran certification to the Department of Motor Vehicles for processing. You may request to have the Office of Veteran's Affairs return this application and the DD Form 214 to you so that you may bring this application to a DMV office or mail the application to the DMV.**
