The category "immediate family" is limited to the following: spouse, household member, mother, father, sister, brother, son, daughter, grandparent, grandchild and a party to a civil union. **Only Vermont Residents are eligible for assignment of a specific low number.**

Note: Effective July 1, 2004, A person who has a low number registration (101 – 9999) on a pleasure car or motor home may also have the same number on a light truck and vice versa, provided at least one name is the same on the registration.
