Only Vermont residents are allowed to obtain an Operator's License, Commercial Driver's License, Enhanced Driver's License/ID, Learner's Permit or Non-Driver Identification Card.

This affidavit may be used as proof of Vermont residency for applicants who are minors, or applicants who are over the age of 18 but reside with others. For proof of residency, the parent, legal guardian, homeowner, leaseholder, etc must provide DMV with **one of the following documents** (with current name and street address):

- Utility bill (must list service address).
- Property tax bill (with physical location).
- Lease or Landlord statement.
- Vermont EBT or Vermont AIM identification card.
- Homeowners/Renters insurance (policy/proof of claim).

US Military, Active Duty:

- If residing in Vermont - see above.
- If residing out of state - military ID and proof that Vermont is your residence in military records, such as Leave and Earnings Statement or orders.

**NOTE:** If you question whether or not a document is acceptable, refer to a Customer Service Specialist or Examiner.
