If the vehicle is **Homemade** or **Rebuilt from Component Parts**, any and all Bills of Sale and/or Titles for the parts used **must** be included. Otherwise this application will be returned to you!

1. Titleable Vehicles – Vermont titles all vehicles 15 years old and newer, **except** the following:
 - ❖ Trailers with empty weight 1,500 pounds or less
 - ❖ Motorcycles/Mopeds with engine size smaller than 300cc
 - ❖ All Terrain Vehicles (ATV's) with model year 2003 and older
 - ❖ Tractors with registered weight of 6,099 pounds or less
2. If your vehicle is a street rod or replica of a street rod, a Motor Vehicle Inspector or a certified street rod inspector must attach the V.I.N. plate. A Certificate of Verification (TA-VN-186) must be completed by the inspector before the vehicle can be registered.
3. **If your vehicle is titleable, a Motor Vehicle Inspector will attach the Vehicle Identification Number Tag. Please give directions to the location of your vehicle:**
