- If plates were seized by law enforcement, you must complete the Petition for Return of Seized Plates (VG-154).

A single plate is $\$ 15.00$ and a set of two plates is $\$ 29.00$. State, Municipal \& Volunteer plates are $\$ 11.00$ each.
Note: If plates have recently expired or are due to expire within the next 30 days, you must also submit the appropriate renewal form and fee(s).

You should receive your replacement plate(s) within 60 days.
When validated, authority is hereby granted for the operation and inspection of your vehicle, with one plate attached to the rear of your vehicle, for 60 days from the validation date. Keep this document with your registration certificate. This document can only be used while your registration is valid.

## Faded Plates

Any Vermont registration plate faded to a point in which its numbers and letters have impaired identification must be replaced. Replacement of faded plates is at no cost to the owner if the fading is caused by faulty materials or a problem with the manufacturing process. Unless you have vanity or low-number plates, you will receive a new plate number. If you wish to keep your current registration number, which is not a vanity or low number, you must pay the replacement plate fee.
