# Issuance of Title for a vehicle not previously required to be titled

Act 41 (signed into law in June 2023) amended 23 V.S.A. § 2012, § 2013 & § 2017, requiring titles for all vehicles as of January 1, 2024. Previously, Vermont only titled vehicles 15 years old or newer at registration.

### I own a vehicle registered in Vermont in my name, but not previously titled

You may obtain a title by completing the appropriate form and paying the applicable title fee

#### I bought a vehicle not previously titled

- If the vehicle was last registered in Vermont, you should have the last registration, a bill of sale, and, if applicable, an odometer disclosure statement from the last registered owner to you.
- If the vehicle was last registered in any jurisdiction other than Vermont, we will run an inquiry to the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS).
  - o If <u>NMVTIS</u> indicates a previous title or registration in any jurisdiction, you must obtain the last title (or registration if non-titleable). If you cannot acquire the aforementioned documents, you may be able to register using the Title Bond process. Additionally, you will need a bill of sale and, if applicable, an odometer disclosure statement (DMV form VT-005) from the last registered owner.
  - If <u>NMVTIS</u> indicates <u>NO</u> previous title or registration in any jurisdiction, you may use this form.
    Additionally, you will need a bill of sale and, if applicable, an odometer disclosure statement (DMV form VT-005) from the last registered owner.

Visual verification of the vehicle identification number (VIN) on <u>DMV form VT-010</u> is required when using this form or the title bond process. For more information on title bonding see dmv.vermont.gov/tax-title/vehicle-title/bonded-title.
